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#### Pork Market Trends:

- Pork exports have been trending higher in recent weeks as world buyers take advantage of the attractive prices in the US market. US hog prices currently are trading at a discount to both EU and Brazil (see page 30 of this report).

- Two consecutive weeks of big sales to Mexico have helped bolster prices for bone-in hams. Boneless ham prices, however, are running below year ago levels as higher prices at retail have curtailed some of the domestic demand.

- Hog slaughter was lower last week as snow storms disrupted transportation of hogs to processing facilities. US hog producers are still incentivized to pull hogs forward as current prices are below cost of production.

- Pork belly inventory at the end of January was a little over 70 million pounds, 57% higher than a year ago. Ample freezer inventories should keep belly prices in check through March. Higher prices are expected in Q2.

#### **Chicken Market Trends:**

- Chicken prices continue to trend higher although the pace of price increases appeared to slow down last week. There is still a lot of chicken in cold storage and this should help temper chicken price inflation in Q2.

- US chicken producers have taken steps to limit supply growth, with egg sets currently running at about the same level as a year ago while chick placements are up just 0.7% in the last four weeks.

- High beef prices in Q2 are expected to drive chicken demand, both at retail and foodservice. We have raised our projections for chicken breasts and b/s thigh meat for Q2 but prices are still expected to be well below year ago.

- Bird flu situation in South America continues to worsen, with Brazil now at heightened risk. It is unknow how the situation will develop but a major outbreak in Brazil will shift more demand to the US market and push prices higher.

#### Beef Market Trends:

- Fed cattle slaughter has declined an average of 5.4% in the last three weeks. This is due to both weather disruptions but also fewer cattle placed on feed last fall. Once we also account for a 2% decline in fed cattle weights, total beef production recently has been down by almost 7.5%.

- The decline in fed beef supplies has caused wholesale beef prices to trend sharply higher and now up 11% from a year ago. Prices are up for most beef items although much of the increase has been driven by high value beef cuts.

- Brisket prices continue provide excellent value, especially when you consider the sharp increase in fed cattle values. We expect S. Korea and Japan to continue to capitalize on this in March and April.

- Brazil suspended its beef exports to China following the discovery of BSE last week. We expect Chinese buyers to be more active in the US market in the next 3-4 weeks.

#### **Turkey Market Trends**

- Turkey prices are mixed as supply has been steadily improving. USDA has reported a few cases of bird flu in turkey operations but the impact has been limited so far.

- Turkey breast prices have declined sharply now that supply is improving. High prices also caused significant demand destruction in 2022. There is currently a lot more turkey meat available in the spot market and we expect prices to remain under pressure in the near term. As for price forecasts, much will depend on the Bird Flu impact this spring. If the impact is limited, then we could see breast meat prices decline another 30% from current levels.

- Turkey drums also hold a softer undertone and we could see further price declines if supply continues to recover. Whole turkey supply will remain limited, however. Much of the increase in supply is due to more processing size birds coming to market.








#### LAYERS ON 1ST OF MONTH: BROILER TYPE HATCHING. '000 Head




#### US WEEKLY BROILER EGG SETS

#### US WEEKLY BROILER CHICK PLACEMENT




# RATIO OF CHICK PLACEMENTS VS. EGG SETS (21 DAY LAG)















