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Pork Market Trends:

- Lean hog futures have declined by more than 10% in the last few days due to ongoing demand uncertainty this spring.
- The supply of pork bellies in cold storage at the end of February was 42% higher than a year ago and prices have been counter seasonally lower. While normally belly prices move up in the spring and summer, processors are sitting on a lot of inventory and there is extreme uncertainty about price direction going forward.
- Ham prices have declined by more than 20%, not unusual considering that processors usually fill their Easter orders by mid March. Current prices appear to be attracting a lot of export interest and expectations are for prices to trend higher in the spring.
- Pork trim prices have also pulled back. Lower slaughter and seasonal improvement in demand is expected to bolster prices in late April and May, however.

Chicken Market Trends:

- We see a two tier market developing in the chicken complex, with lower prices for chicken breasts but higher prices for leg quarters and thigh meat.
- The front half of the bird tends to rely more on domestic demand and, after a big jump in Jan/Feb, prices appear to have taken a step back. The supply of chicken breasts in cold storage at the end of February was 41% higher than a year ago. Retail demand has slowed down and with limited freezer space, processors are looking for bids and sales are getting done below quoted market. But we expect retail features for breast meat to increase in April and May, which should pressure prices higher.
- The supply of leg quarters in cold storage was 32% lower than last year. Export demand remains robust, resulting in limited spot availability and higher prices. With limited supply growth, dark meat prices are expected to move up.

Beef Market Trends:

- Wholesale beef prices continue to trade firm as supply is well below year ago and it is only expected to get tighter going into spring. We estimate fed cattle slaughter last week down 4.4% from last year and combined with a 2% decline in fed cattle weights we think fed beef production was down by almost 6.5% y/y.
- The decline in both slaughter and weights has significantly limited the supply of fat beef trimmings. Demand for this item will seasonally improve in April and May as retailers prepare for Memorial Day grilling features while foodservice normally sees an improvement in customer traffic.
- Lean beef prices have been steadily increasing as well, with beef cow slaughter down by double digits from last year.
- Export demand rebounded last week, with sales to S. Korea and Japan rebounding. This continues to underpin prices for outside skirts as well as chuck rolls and short plates.

Turkey Market Trends

- Bird flu remains in the headlines but the impact so far this year has been extremely limited. Losses at turkey farms have been minimal and this has resulted in more supply hitting the market.
- Turkey prices are lower across all categories, with breast meat prices seeing the biggest declines, down by more than 50% since the start of the year. Our current forecast is for turkey breast meat prices to find a bottom sometime in the summer.
- What is unknown at this time is the degree of demand destruction due to the record prices last year. Also unknown is the trajectory of Bird Flu cases in North and South America.
- Turkey market is likely to remain volatile through May, at which time we should have a better idea about price potential. For now the price trend in this market is down.







BONELESS-SKINLESS TURKEY BREAST, TOM, FRESH, USDA


TURKEY MEAT - SCAPULA, FROZEN, USDA, WT.AVG.








TURKEY THIGH, FRESH, USDA






PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS




CATTLE MARKETINGS, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS

FEEDLOT TURN-OVER RATE (MARKETINGS VS. INVENTORY)










CONTRIBUTION TO YEAR/YEAR CHANGE IN MEXICO BEEF PRODUCTION






Mexico Beef Imports




Beef Carcass Prices
