Pork Market Trends:

- Market remains highly uncertain. Bellies have been and continue to be a major drag for the wholesale index, accounting for about half of the decline in wholesale prices. With large inventories and expected lower California demand, the price upside risk for bellies is lower than in previous years.

- Enforcement of Prop 12 law in California will commence in July but California officials are saying that initially they will focus on education rather than strict enforcement. They also suggested they will allow product in inventory to continue to flow to consumers even if its not compliant with the law. This helped bolstered futures at the end of the week.

- Retail pork demand has been mixed. Pork shoulder has benefited from the high price of beef and it is currently trading near year ago. Pork loins, however, are facing more competition from chicken and are down almost 20% y/y.

Chicken Market Trends:

- Weekly broiler slaughter in May averaged 1.7% above year ago levels. USDA data shows that slaughter of heavy birds, which are mostly for processing, 5.1% higher than a year ago. Jumbo b/s breast prices have not experienced the normal seasonal increase on ample supply and slower than expected foodservice sales.

- The supply of b/s chicken breasts in cold storage at the end of April was 27% higher than a year ago. While freezer inventory is slowly declining, the still large supply has helped keep prices in check.

- The back half of the bird has generally performed better but even there we are seeing a slowdown. Leg quarter prices were very firm in April but export competition has increased with HPAI fears resulting in more offers and big discounts from Brazil. Lower pork trim prices and softer hot dog demand has negatively impacted MSC prices.

Beef Market Trends:

- Cattle prices were sharply higher last week, causing futures traders to bid up prices as much as 5% for the week. The increase in cattle futures also follows higher prices for equities, seen as a bet on future economic performance.

- The price performance of specific beef cuts varies greatly, however. Fat beef trim prices remain firm due to lower slaughter, seasonal ground beef demand and lower fed cattle weights. Lean beef prices, on the other hand, have been stuck around the same price for the past four months.

- Prices for top butts and other loin cuts have seen robust demand this spring. Higher prices and summer heat will start to pressure wholesale values in late June and July, however.

- Chuck and round cuts are expected to trade sideways in the near term but they face more upside price risk in the fall as demand seasonally improves and supplies remain tight.

Turkey Market Trends

- In the near term supply is significantly better than it was a year ago, resulting in downward pressure on prices. USDA reported that weekly slaughter in May averaged 14.5% above year ago levels.

- With limited HPAI risk in the next three months, sellers are trying to present more competitive offers, especially for frozen product. This includes breast and thigh meat as well as MST.

- The increase in poult placements in Q4 of last year and Q1 of this year will help keep markets well supplied in the near term. However, current prices are not financially sustainable and in April producers reduced the number of poults placed by 1 million birds. We think May and June placements will be down as well. HPAI has not disappeared and combined with lower placements, we see increased price risk for turkey this fall, especially for fresh product.












Primal Loin Cutout Value, USDA, Daily, \$/cwt


