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Pork Market Trends:

- The quarterly survey of hog operations suggests that pork supply in 2024 will be modestly higher than in 2023. The breeding herd inventory is down 2% from a year ago but the reduction has been more than offset by productivity gains.
- Demand has been far stronger than most expected, resulting in steady gains for late spring and summer.
- There is also speculation that consumers may be trading down, which tends to support lower priced protein options like pork. Pork prices at retail have increased at a far lower pace than beef and chicken, making it more competitive.
- Ham prices surged higher after Easter, in part due to the reduction in slaughter during the holidays but also two weeks of big export sales (55k MT) to Mexico.
- Trim prices firm and expected to move higher in May/Jun.

Chicken Market Trends:

- The supply picture has yet to improve. USDA has been consistently revising lower its initial slaughter estimates. Since the start of the year, weekly slaughter has routinely been 1.5 to 2% lower than a year ago. USDA and private forecasts last fall were pointing to supply growth due to lower feed costs and competitive advantage vs. beef.
- Producers have been increasing egg sets in an effort to bolster supply but so far poor productivity has largely blunted that effort. Supply is expected to slowly improve in May but at levels lower than previously expected.
- Chicken prices have been steady and market participants note there has been an improvement in spot supplies. But this is mostly due to a slowdown in retail demand than due to supply growth.
- Broiler hatchery flock declined in March, defying expectations and suggesting limited supply growth in 2024.

Beef Market Trends:

- Cattle futures have come under significant pressure as speculators cut back bullish positions given the backlog of cattle in feedlots, counter seasonal increase in cattle weights and slowdown in sales of high value cuts.
- Fat beef trim prices are running as much as 35% under last year, in part due to the increase in fed cattle weights but also the lower value of livestock and vegetable fats.
- Seasonally the value of rounds and chucks is lower in Q2 and this year is no difference. The lack of lean grinding beef will tend to set a floor under prices. Flats and inside rounds are currently trading under grinding value.
- Steak cuts have more upside risk although the timing may be affected by the early Easter this year. Current pullback in price provides domestic retailers and export buyers with an opportunity to cover needs before grilling demand kicks in.
- Inside skirts firm on lower slaughter, limited spot supply.

Turkey Market Trends

- Turkey market has a demand problem, not a supply problem. Facing the uncertainty of HPAI and poor returns, producers have steadily reduced supply in grow out houses. Poult placements between November and February were down 5.1 million head (-6.1%) vs. a year ago. This will limit turkey slaughter during Apr-Jul.
- Turkeys lost during Oct/Nov to HPAI have already started to impact supply availability. However, breast meat market remains heavy. Evidence of this is the discount of 80 cents or more between frozen and fresh turkey breast, suggesting slow sales are forcing processors to sell off inventory before they run into shelf life issues.
- Turkey exports in February were 55% higher than a year ago. The expected shortfall in production and robust export demand in Q2 will tend to bolster prices for thighs and drums. Already market called firm and trending higher.








Beef Carcass Prices









